


This releationship has the greatest effect in young children, so it's important to reach new parents so that they may use this knowledge in their everyday lives in raising their children.












Research and consideration of target audience was important in the design of this website. The thesis topic and campaign has always be geared towards parents of young children as well as there children.

The over all goal of the Gut Buddy website would be to turn a complex topic into something that busy parents could learn about quickly, and something kids and their parents would find visually appealing.
















